### **Chamber Elects Dr. Arlene Garrison to Board**

Dr. Arlene A. Garrison, Vice President, University Partnerships, Oak Ridge Associated Universities, has been elected to serve on the Anderson County Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors.

Garrison, with more than 35 years of experience in science and education, works with the Oak Ridge National Laboratory to enhance and expand research participation programs that provide opportunities for faculty and students from ORAU member institutions to work alongside renowned ORNL scientists. Prior to ORAU she served as a program director for the National Science Foundation and a number of senior leadership positions with the University of Tennessee Knoxville. Garrison holds a doctorate in analytical chemistry and a bachelor's degree in electrical engineering from the University of Tennessee.

Active in community and scientific organizations, Garrison currently serves on the National Science Foundation Advisory Committee for the Small Business Innovation Research program. She also is alternate councilor for the East Tennessee Section of the American Chemical Society, a member of the American Chemical Society budget and finance committee, and serves on the board of the Southern Appalachian Science and Engineering Fair.

# **SL Tennessee Announces**

#### \$80.5 Million Expansion and 1,000 New Jobs

Governor Bill Haslam announced SL Tennessee, LLC will construct a new 250,000 square foot building to join its two existing facilities in the Clinton/I-75 Industrial Park. The South Korean automotive parts manufacturer will invest \$80.5 million and create 1,000 new jobs in Anderson County. Located in Clinton since 2001, this will be the company's fifth expansion. Construction will begin in August 2014 with a goal of being fully operational by April 2015.
