Pre-registration: ALL Entries must pre-register by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, December 2, 2019

Parade check in: Jaycee Park 4:00 Noon – 5:30 p.m.

Parade Santa: Parade Santa will be **ONLY** Santa in the parade – Please! **Restrictions:** Entries must be no taller than 13' and no longer than 26'

Candy: FOR SAFETY REASONS, PLEASE ASK YOUR GROUP TO BE CAREFUL

IN DISTRIBUTING CANDY TO PARADE WATCHERS!

DO NOT THROW AT CAMERA!

Horses: <u>Must have on a diaper!</u>

(All animals) City Ordinance requires owners to pick up after their pets.

Drivers: ALL drivers must be 16 years of age with a valid TN driver's license. Vehicle

must be "street legal" with a TAG. NO ATVs. STRICTLY ENFORCED!

PARTICIPANT INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for participating in Clinton's "A Small Town Christmas" Parade.

- The Parade will begin at **6:00 p.m. Saturday, December 7, 2019**. All floats, cars, and emergency vehicles must enter at Jaycee Park.
- Registration and check-in for your designated area will begin at 4:00 p.m, where you will be assigned a number. Volunteers will then direct you out of the park and down Nave Street to Eagle Bend Road and line up behind the entry in front of you as far to the right as possible.
- <u>Cars, Pickup Trucks & Motorcycles</u> All vehicles must be "street legal" and the driver must have a valid driver's license. No ATVs. No skateboards. No bicycles. <u>No exceptions!</u>
- <u>Emergency Vehicles/Tow Trucks/Military Vehicles</u> Please line up on Christin Drive. Please enter from Field Drive. A volunteer will be there to check you in.
- Floats any vehicle pulling a trailer, etc. (limit 26' trailer)
- <u>Horses</u> please check-in at 5:00 p.m. Please park at the riding arena on Field Drive. There will be a volunteer in your area to check you in. You will then proceed down Christin Drive and will be fed into the parade. Someone will need to take your horse trailer to the parking lot area behind the Clinton Community Center.

Horses are required to wear a diaper per Clinton City ordinance.

- Riding & Walking groups: Please park in the Municipal Parking lot and then meet at Clinch River Mercantile, 428 Eagle Bend Road. Walking groups will be fed into the parade. Riding groups will walk back to load onto their float once float is staged on Eagle Bend. (An adult must accompany all groups of children.)
- The parade ends behind the Clinton Community Center. All entries that need to unload passengers and secure items on the float before leaving the parade area <u>MUST</u> pull into the designated parking area. Please make arrangements to pick up walking groups, etc. Horse trailers must be brought to the recycling center lot behind the Community Center.
- ALL ENTRIES WITH ANIMALS Pet owners are required by City
 Ordinance to "remove animal waste". A violation may result in a citation to court.
